Re: It Happened Last Night

The Evergreen Local Board of Education met in regular session last night, Thursday, November 16, 2017 at 7 p.m. There were 11 visitors present.

Ashley Garlick, Evergreen High School senior, presented plans to organize a community-wide effort in order to raise donations to purchase 50,000 meals for area food banks.

Superintendent Jim Wyse shared that Ohio's State Board of Education has granted Evergreen Local Schools with the 2016 – 2017 Momentum Award. This recognition is for districts that receive all A's on each Value-Added measure included on Ohio's school and district report cards.

The Board conducted the following business:

- \* Approved the October financial reports presented by the Treasurer.
- \* Approved the transfer of \$18,497.25 from 003-7200-910-9011 HB 264 PI Transfers-Out and \$85,910.00 from 003-7200-910-0000 PI Transfers-Out to 002-5100-9011 HB264 Energy Conservation Project Transfers-In, and approved the following debt payments due December 1, 2017:
  - 1) Refunded Series 2001 bond principal and interest of \$777,687.18.
  - 2) Refunded Series 2002 bond principal and interest of \$126,262.50.
  - 3) Series 2010 HB264 Energy Conservation Bonds principal and interest of \$104,407.25.
- \* Approved the following federal grant fund reallocations and carryovers for FY18, amended resources and modified appropriations accordingly:

\* Approved Emily Herr as a High School/Junior High School paid or volunteer event worker for the 2017 – 2018 school year, to be paid from the Athletic Fund.

\* Employed Kathryn Truckor on an hourly, as-needed basis to provide special education assistance in elementary classrooms for the 2017 – 2018 school year, at a rate of \$27.50 per hour.

\* Approved a resolution to support Ohio Senate Bill 216 (Public School Mandate Deregulation).

\* Approved a bridge agreement as an addendum to the current depository agreement with Huntington Bank, acknowledging Huntington Bank’s transition to the Ohio Pooled Collateral Program (OPCP) detailed in section 135.182 of the Ohio Revised Code. Huntington will collateralize deposits of the Evergreen Local School District at the level designated by the State using their SCALE rating system of banks. This agreement is for the period of November 15, 2017 through December 31, 2020, which is the same expiration date as the current depository agreement.
