The Evergreen Local Board of Education met in regular session last night, Wednesday, February 7, 2018 at 7 p.m. There were 16 visitors present.

The Board conducted the following business:

- \* Approved the January, 2018 financial reports including the Cash Reconciliation, BALCHK report, Financial summary reports (FINSUM and FINSUMM), Financial Report (FUNDSUMM), and Annual Spending Plan.
- \* Accepted a \$200.00 anonymous donation to 018-9220 Student Assistance Fund.
- \* Approved a revised Auxiliary Services Agreement with the Educational Service Center of Lake Erie West for the 2017-2018 school year in the amount of \$84,529.68, for services of Auxiliary Services personnel for the benefit of Holy Trinity School.
- \* Approved Kim Reckner and Kelley Carmean as instructors for the after school Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math (STEAM) program. Each instructor shall log time for the program, estimated to be 28 hours per employee and at \$27.50 per hour.
