New Student Attendance Policy for 2026-2027

The state of Ohio has changed the law regarding school attendance. Beginning with the 2026-2027 school year, a doctor's note is no longer exempt from attendance hours; this means anytime a student is not in the building (for any reason) it will count toward his/her absent hours which could result in chronic absenteeism. School administrators will continue to collaborate with the Fulton County Courts, Fulton County truancy officer, and other county schools to develop specific guidelines for the district.

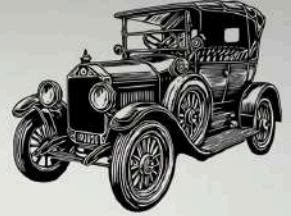

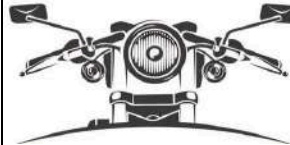
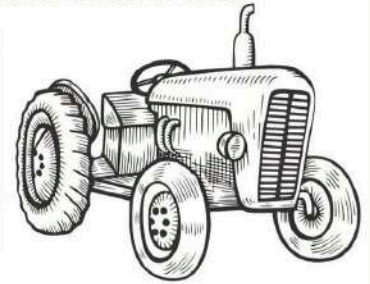
